ELLYN RUTENSCHROER was born in Cincinnati, OH to parents Gilbert and Helen Rutenschroer.

In 1958, Ellyn married Kenneth Kern. They had 4 children: Deborah (Kern) Wildrick, Douglas MacArthur Kern, Lincoln Warren Kern, Bennett Marshal Kern and 2 step children Andrea Kern and Brian Kern.

In 1959, she received a Bachelor Degree in Sociology from the University of Cincinnati.

In 1965, the Kern family moved to Indianapolis, Indiana where they felt their Democratic ideologies would be more welcomed.

From 1963 to 1965, Ellyn was President and Manager of Tri-State Country Club in Bennington, IN. Beginning in 1965, Ellyn was Publisher and writer with Cottontail Publications in Bennington, IN. From 1974-1986, she was Office Manager for her husband's company Kenneth C. Kern and Associates in Indianapolis, IN.
